Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Mr. Gruber:

Final Finish, LLC was issued a Registration No. 039-19404-00559 on September 1, 2004, for a stationary wood surface coating facility located at 1601 West Hively Avenue, Elkhart, Indiana, 46517. On July 17, 2007, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a letter from the source requesting a transfer of ownership and company name change to Nextech Corporation. The letter also stated that as part of the transfer of ownership, all emission units at the Final Finish plant were to be moved to a building owned by Nextech Corporation located at 1600 West Mishawaka Road, Elkhart, Indiana, 46517 on an adjoining property just south of the Final Finish plant. IDEM, OAQ has determined that Final Finish, LLC and Nextech Corporation are considered one source under 326 IAC 1-2-73, since they are under common control, have the same two digit SIC code (Major Group 25), and are located on contiguous properties. This change is considered a notice-only change pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6.

IDEM, OAQ has decided to make additional revisions to the registration as described below. The registration is revised as follows with deleted language as ~~strikeouts~~ and new language **bolded**:

1. IDEM has begun implementing a new procedure and will no longer list the name or title of the Authorized Individual (A.I.) in the registration. The registration annual notification form has been updated to delete the Authorized Individual (A.I.).
2. Application of surface coatings in spray booth SB-1 has potential particulate emissions that are greater than five hundred fifty-one thousandths (0.551) pound per hour and has the potential to use greater than five (5) gallons per day of surface coatings. Therefore, the requirements of 326 IAC 6-3-2(d) are applicable to spray booth SB-1. The requirements for spray booth SB-1 are revised as follows:

~~The PM emissions are from the surface coating unit shall be limited to 0.82 pounds per hour, based on a process weight rate of 81.32 pounds per hour.~~

Pursuant to 326 IAC 6-3-2(d) (Particulate Emissions Limitations), the Permittee shall comply with the following:

- (a) Particulate from the spray booth SB-1 shall be controlled by a dry particulate filter, and the Permittee shall operate the control device in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.**
- (b) If overspray is visibly detected at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground, the Permittee shall inspect the control device and do either of the following no later than four (4) hours after such observation:**

- (1) Repair control device so that no overspray is visibly detectable at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground.**
- (2) Operate equipment so that no overspray is visibly detectable at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground.**
- (c) If overspray is visibly detected, the Permittee shall maintain a record of the action taken as a result of the inspection, any repairs of the control device, or change in operations, so that overspray is not visibly detected at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground. These records must be maintained for five (5) years.**

These changes are considered notice-only changes pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6, the registration is hereby revised. All other conditions of the registration shall remain unchanged and in effect. The source shall continue to operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5. Please find enclosed the revised registration.

Registered Construction and Operation Status

Dear Mr. Gruber:

Final Finish, LLC was issued a Registration No. 039-19404-00559 on September 1, 2004, for a stationary wood surface coating facility located at 1601 West Hively Avenue, Elkhart, Indiana, 46517. On July 17, 2007, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a letter from the source requesting a transfer of ownership and company name change to Nextech Corporation. The letter also stated that as part of the transfer of ownership, all emission units at the Final Finish plant were to be moved to a building owned by Nextech Corporation located at 1600 West Mishawaka Road, Elkhart, Indiana, 46517 on an adjoining property just south of the Final Finish plant. IDEM, OAQ has determined that Final Finish, LLC and Nextech Corporation are considered one source under 326 IAC 1-2-73, since they are under common control, have the same two digit SIC code (Major Group 25), and are located on contiguous properties.

Based on the data submitted and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-5.5, it has been determined that the following stationary wood surface coating facility, located at 1600 West Mishawaka Road, Elkhart, Indiana, 46517 is classified as registered:

- (a) One (1) spray booth, identified as SB-1, with a maximum capacity of 181.32 pounds per hour, equipped with dry filters, with a control efficiency of 90%.
- (b) Ten (10) radiant heaters, identified as H1 through H10, each with a maximum heat input rate of 0.08 MMBtu per hour.
- (c) One (1) air make-up unit, identified as H11, with a maximum heat input rate of 2.2 MMBTU per hour.
- (d) A sanding system, with a maximum capacity of 307.44 pounds per hour, equipped with a cyclone with baghouse, with a control efficiency of 99%.

The following conditions shall be applicable:

1. Pursuant to 326 IAC 5-1-2 (Opacity Limitations) except as provided in 326 IAC 5-1-3 (Temporary Alternative Opacity Limitations), opacity shall meet the following:
 - (a) Opacity shall not exceed an average of forty percent (in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period as determined in 326 IAC 5-1-4.
 - (b) Opacity shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) for more than a cumulative total of 15 minutes (60 readings) in a 6-hour period as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix

A, Method 9 for fifteen (15) one (1) minute overlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor in a six (6) hour period.

2. Pursuant to 326 IAC 6-3-2 (Particulate Emissions Limitations), the particulate matter (PM) from the sander shall be limited to 1.17 pounds per hour based on a process weight rate of 307.4 pounds per hour

Interpolation of the data in the table in 326 IAC 6-3-2(e)(2) for the process weight rates up to sixty thousand (60,000) pounds per hour shall be accomplished by use of the equation:

$$E = 4.10 P^{0.67} \quad \text{where } E = \text{rate of emission in pounds per hour, and} \\ P = \text{process weight rate in tons per hour}$$

The baghouse shall be in operation at all times the sander is in operation in order to comply with this limit.

3. Pursuant to 326 IAC 6-3-2(d) (Particulate Emissions Limitations), the Permittee shall comply with the following:
- (a) Particulate from the spray booth SB-1 shall be controlled by a dry particulate filter, and the Permittee shall operate the control device in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.
 - (b) If overspray is visibly detected at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground, the Permittee shall inspect the control device and do either of the following no later than four (4) hours after such observation:
 - (1) Repair control device so that no overspray is visibly detectable at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground.
 - (2) Operate equipment so that no overspray is visibly detectable at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground.
 - (c) If overspray is visibly detected, the Permittee shall maintain a record of the action taken as a result of the inspection, any repairs of the control device, or change in operations, so that overspray is not visibly detected at the exhaust or accumulates on the ground. These records must be maintained for five (5) years.

This source remains a registered source. The source may operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5.

An authorized individual shall provide an annual notice to the Office of Air Quality that the source is in operation and in compliance with this registration pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(3). The annual notice shall be submitted to:

no later than March 1 of each year, with the annual notice being submitted in the format attached.

An application or notification shall be submitted in accordance with 326 IAC 2 to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) if the source proposes to construct new emission units, modify existing emission units, or otherwise modify the source.
