Notice of Decision: Approval - Effective Immediately

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this permit is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3 and IC 13-15-6-1 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days of the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

On August 10, 2007, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an interim significant source modification petition from Coachmen Recreational Vehicle Co., LLC., 423 North Main, Middlebury, Indiana for construction of three spray booths.

Public notice of the interim significant source modification petition was published on August 18, 2007. The public comment period ended on September 1, 2007.

There were no comments received during the public comment period. This interim significant source modification petition expires on the effective date of the final significant source modification permit.

The interim significant source modification petition may be revoked after the effective date upon a written finding by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) that any of the reasons for denial in 326 IAC 2-13-1(h) exist or if the final significant source modification permit is denied. The IDEM has reviewed this interim significant source modification petition and has not found any such reason. The facilities specified in the interim significant source modification petition may not operate until the final significant permit modification is issued by OAQ.

The interim significant source modification petition is federally enforceable. Detailed construction and operation conditions will be specified in the final significant source modification permit 039-25130-00062.

Request for Interim Construction Approval**

Dear Madam/Sir:

Please find enclosed an application for Coachmen Recreational Vehicle Company, LLC to modify the above referenced air permit. The source is located in Elkhart County, Indiana and produces recreational vehicles. The source is currently permitted for VOC emissions of 249 tons per year, with current actual emissions of approximately 32 tons per year.

Coachmen Recreational Vehicle Company, LLC is requesting that three additional paint spray booths be permitted at plant 220 for the purpose of painting recreational vehicles. Potential VOC emissions from this new operation will be approximately 281 tons per year. Calculated VOC actual emissions from these booths are expected to be approximately 22 TPY. In addition, Coachman Recreational Vehicle Company, LLC, requests interim construction approval for the three additional paint spray booths pursuant to 326 IAC 2-13. Please note that the proposed booths will be coating plastics, and therefore, are not subject to the requirements of 326 IAC 8-2-9.

Coachmen Recreational Vehicle Company, LLC requests that IDEM amend permit number T039-17984 to include this additional emission source and does not seek to modify the 249 TPY VOC emission limit already permitted. **Coachmen Recreational Vehicle Company, LLC requests a 25 ton per year emission limit on the new operation both to fulfill the requirements of 326 IAC 8-1-6, and to expedite the processing of the permit modification by ensuring that the proposed modification, with the proposed limitation, is minor.** Total allowable VOC emissions at the facility should remain at 249 TPY.
