### Notice of Decision: Revocation

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(f) this revocation is effective fifteen (15) days after it is served. When served by U.S. mail, the order is effective eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-2(e).

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 and IC 13-15-7-3 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition describing your intent must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Mr. Troup:

On January 30, 2004, Johnson Controls, Inc., was issued a MSOP No. 039-17604-00018 for a stationary source that manufactures controls for heating, refrigeration, air conditioning and pump devices, located at 1302 East Monroe Street, Goshen, Indiana 46528. On August 1, 2007, the Office of Air Quality received a letter from JCI, notifying OAQ that the plant (consisting of 2 boilers) is no longer owned by JCI. However, JCI still owns the six (6) air strippers associated with groundwater remediation system at the source. JCI provided information indicating that the air strippers have source-wide potential emissions that are less than the exemption thresholds in 326 IAC 2-1.1-3.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-3 this source satisfies the criteria to operate under the Exemption provisions. Accordingly, Johnson Controls, Inc., is now operating under the Exemption No. 039-25099-00018 that supersedes MSOP No. 039-17604-00018.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any cause that establishes in the judgment of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of 326 IAC 2. Since the source is now operating as an exempt source, the MSOP No. 039-17604-00018-00039 is now superseded and is no longer needed.

The MSOP No. 039-17604-00018 issued on January 30, 2004, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective in eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.
