### Notice of Decision: Revocation

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(f) this revocation is effective fifteen (15) days after it is served. When served by U.S. mail, the order is effective eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-2(e).

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 and IC 13-15-7-3 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition describing your intent must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Steve Derdzinski:

On March 21, 2006, WVP Acquisition Corporation d/b/a WeVac Plastics, was issued a FESOP, No. F039-22495-00362, for a stationary vacuum molded plastic parts manufacturing source, located at 2401 South 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Elkhart, Indiana. On August 24, 2007, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a letter from WVP Acquisition Corporation d/b/a WeVac Plastics stating their intent to operate under the Minor Source Operating Permit (MSOP) provisions. Based on the delisting of Methyl Ethyl Ketone (MEK), as a Hazardous Air Pollutant, by both the US EPA., on December 19, 2005, and the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, on November 23, 2006, WeVac Plastic's updated emission calculations demonstrated that the source-wide potential to emit Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) is now less than the Title V thresholds of ten (10) tons per year for any single HAP, and less than twenty-five (25) tons per year for any combination of HAPs. Therefore, pursuant to 326 IAC 2-6.1, this source satisfies the criteria to operate under the MSOP provisions. Accordingly, WVP Acquisition Corporation d/b/a WeVac Plastics, applied for and was issued an MSOP No. M039-25191-00362, which supersedes FESOP No. F039-22495-00362.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any cause that establishes in the judgment of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of 326 IAC 2. Since the source now operating under an MSOP, the FESOP No. F039-22495-00362 is now superseded and is no longer needed.

The FESOP No. F039-22495-00362 issued on March 21, 2006, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective in eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.
