Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Quicksilver Resources, Inc. - Wimp Central Processing Facility was issued a Registration No. 061-24475-00028 on July 18, 2007, for a stationary natural gas compression and dehydration station located at SE/4 NE/4, Section 31, T4S, R4E, Corydon, IN 47112. On November 27, 2007 the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an application from the source requesting that the registration be updated to indicate a transfer of ownership and a company name change. Based on this request, IDEM has updated its records to reflect the transfer of ownership and revised the registration to reflect the new company name change to Breitburn Operating LP - Wimp Central Processing Facility. The change is considered a notice-only change pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6(d)(2) and 326 IAC 2-5.5-6(d)(3).

The source shall continue to operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5. Please find enclosed the revised registration.

Dear Ms. Brock:

The application from Breitburn Operating LP - Wimp Central Processing Facility, received on November 27, 2007, to change the company name, has been reviewed. Based on the data submitted and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-5.1, IDEM has determined that the following natural gas compression and dehydration station, located at SE/4 NE/4, Section 31, T4S, R4E, Corydon, IN 47112, is classified as registered:

- (a) One (1) 1,265 horsepower lean burn natural gas fired compressor engine, identified as C-3, with a maximum heat input capacity of 9.55 MMBtu/hr, constructed in 2004, and exhausting to stack S-5. This compressor engine is a Caterpillar G3516.
- (b) One (1) natural gas fired glycol dehydrator, identified as D-1, constructed in September, 2003, consisting of one (1) reboiler rated at 0.125 MMBtu/hr, exhausting to Stack S-3, and one (1) dehydrator with a capacity of 40 gallons of glycol per hour, exhausting to Stack S-4.
- (c) One (1) natural gas fired glycol dehydrator, identified as D-2, constructed in September, 2003, consisting of one (1) reboiler rated at 0.125 MMBtu/hr, exhausting to Stack S-7, and one (1) dehydrator with a capacity of 40 gallons of glycol per hour, exhausting to Stack S-8.

The following conditions shall be applicable:

- (a) Pursuant to 326 IAC 5-1-2 (Opacity Limitations) except as provided in 326 IAC 5-1-3 (Temporary Alternative Opacity Limitations), opacity shall meet the following:
 - (1) Opacity shall not exceed an average of forty percent (40%) in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period as determined in 326 IAC 5-1-4.
 - (2) Opacity shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) for more than a cumulative total of fifteen (15) minutes (sixty (60) readings as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9 or fifteen (15) one (1) minute nonoverlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor) in a six (6) hour period.

- (b) Pursuant to 326 IAC 6-4 (Fugitive Dust Emissions), the Permittee shall not allow fugitive dust to escape beyond the property line or boundaries of the property, right-of-way, or easement on which the source is located, in a manner that would violate 326 IAC 6-4 (Fugitive Dust Emissions).

The source may continue to operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5.

An authorized individual shall provide an annual notice to the Office of Air Quality that the source is in operation and in compliance with this registration pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(3). The annual notice shall be submitted to:

no later than March 1 of each year, with the annual notice being submitted in the format attached.

An application or notification shall be submitted in accordance with 326 IAC 2 to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) if the source proposes to construct new emission units, modify existing emission units, or otherwise modify the source.
