Part 70 Operating Permit 085-6040-00009

Dear Ms. Woodward,

R. R. Donnelley & Sons Company operates a publication printing operation located at 2801 West Old Road 30, Warsaw, IN 46580-8783. On April 30, 2008, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a request to extend the construction approval for Significant Source Modification 085-20370-00009 due to construction having been suspended for a continuous period of more than one (1) year. Significant Source Modification 085-20370-00009, which authorizes construction of two (2) heatset offset lithographic printing presses, was issued to the source on March 31, 2005. Construction of the first press was completed in May, 2006. Review Request 085-24970-00009 issued on July 25, 2007 extended the time to begin construction until June 27, 2008. However, construction of the second press has not yet begun due to current market forces and customer demands.

State rule 326 IAC 2-1.1-9 states that any permit authorizing construction may be revoked if construction of the emission unit has not commenced within eighteen (18) months from the date of issuance of the permit, or if during the construction, work is suspended for a continuous period of one (1) year or more.

There have been no changes in air rule applicability to the printing presses since the date of issuance of Significant Source Modification 085-20370-00009 on March 31, 2005. As a result, a new permit to authorize construction, if one was issued on April 30, 2008 (the date that the extension request was received by OAQ) would have the same requirements as in Significant Source Modification 085-20370-00009. Therefore, OAQ agrees to the extension provided that construction of the second press begins prior to April 30, 2009.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9.5(a), the approval to construct is issued for a fixed term of five (5) years from the issuance date of the permit. As a result, the approval to construct the second printing press continues to have an expiration date of November 30, 2010. Construction of the second press must therefore be completed by that date.
