## Notice of Decision: Approval - Effective Immediately

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this permit is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3 and IC 13-15-6-1 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days of the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Ms. Peck:

On August 14, 2008, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an interim minor source modification petition from Ball Metal Beverage Container Corporation, located at 501 North Sixth Street, Monticello, Indiana. Based on the data and information submitted in the petition and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-13-1, this interim minor source modification petition is hereby approved for the following:

### **Proposed Emission Units and Pollution Control Equipment:**

- (a) One (1) lithographic printing press for printing and overvarnish:
  - (1) One (1) approved for construction in 2008, identified as PTR-5, with a maximum worst case emission capacity which is based on 43,200 cans per hour, variable can sizes and line speeds are possible within the VOC emission cap, with one (1) natural gas-fired drying oven (PO-5), rated at less than ten (10) MMBtu/hr, and exhausting to the thermal oxidizer RTO-1.
- (b) One (1) inside spray machine line:
  - (1) One (1) approved for construction in 2008, identified as ISM-5, with a maximum worst case emission capacity which is based on 43,200 cans per hour, variable can sizes and line speeds are possible within the VOC emission cap, each using airless application systems with filtering so that no overspray is visibly detectable at the exhaust, with natural gas drying oven (ISO-5), with three (3) burners, two rated at less than 1 MMBtu/hr and one at less than 0.4 MMBtu/hr each, and exhausting to thermal oxidizer RTO-1.

### **Insignificant Activities:**

- (a) One (1) ultraviolet bottom coater, approved for construction in 2008, identified as UV-05, with a maximum worst case emission capacity which is based on 43,200 cans per hour, variable can sizes and line speeds are possible within the VOC emission cap, with VOC emission less than three (3) pounds per hour and fifteen (15) pounds per day;
- (b) One (1) ID system, consisting of ink and cleanup solvents with a VOC potential to emit less than three (3) pounds per hour and less than fifteen (15) pounds per day;

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- (c) One (1) line of equipment for metal working, processing hot water, closed loop heating and cooling, and ovens with natural gas burners less than 10 MMBtu/hr, including: one (1) natural gas-fired Washer Drying Oven, approved for construction in 2008, identified as WO-L5, rated at less than 10 MMBtu/hr.

Detailed conditions will be specified in the final minor source modification no. 181-26874-00022. This interim minor source modification expires on the effective date of the final minor source modification.

This interim minor source modification may be revoked after its effective date upon a written finding by the OAQ that any of the reasons for denial in 326 IAC 2-13-1(h) exist or if the final minor source modification is denied. The facilities subject to this approval may not operate until the final minor source modification is issued by OAQ.

The interim minor source modification petition is federally enforceable.
