Notice of Decision: Approval - Effective Immediately

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this permit is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3 and IC 13-15-6-1 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days of the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

On August 25, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an Interim Permit Revision Petition from Firestone Industrial Products, located at 1700 Firestone Blvd, Noblesville, Indiana. Based on the data and information submitted in the petition and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-13-1, this Interim Permit Revision Petition is hereby approved for an installation of a new curing press. The description of the new curing press is as follows:

One (1) curing press, identified as 127, approved for construction in 2008, throughout capacity of 45 pounds of compounded rubber per hour, and operating without control device.

Detailed conditions will be specified in the final Permit Revision 057-26935-00006. This Interim Permit Revision Petition Approval expires on the effective date of the final Permit Revision 057-26935-00006. This Interim Permit Revision Petition Approval may be revoked after its effective date upon a written finding by the OAQ that any of the reasons for denial in 326 IAC 2-13-1(h) exist or if the Permit Revision is denied. The facility subject to this approval may not operate until the Permit Revision is issued by OAQ.

Description of The Operation or Equipment:

Firestone is installing a new curing press which has the rated capacity of 45 lbs/hr. No air pollution control device will be installed for this equipment. Firestone currently operates 53 curing presses (emission units 030-082) which are permitted for 1600 lbs/hour of throughput. The additional equipment will allow Firestone to operate 54 curing presses and total capacity will be 1645 lbs/hour (emission units 030-082, 127)

Potential To Emit:

The potential to emit of VOC's will increase from 6.4 tons/yr to 6.6 tons/yr. The potential to emit HAP's will increase from 1.77 tons/yr to 1.81 tons/yr. Calculations for revision in plant capacity are attached.

PSD Requirements:

The potential to emit is less than the PSD Significant levels, therefore, PSD rules and requirements do not apply.

NSPS Requirements:

There is not an applicable NSPS rule to this operation or equipment.

NESHAP Requirements:

There is not an applicable NESHAP rule applicable to this operation or equipment.

State Rules & Requirements:

State rules and requirements would not change with the installation of the additional equipment.


