Zionsville Terminal - Buckeye Terminals, LLC was issued a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) Renewal No. F097-26127-00077 on March 3, 2009 for a stationary bulk petroleum product storage and transfer terminal located at 5405 West 96th Street, Indianapolis, Indiana. On April 3, 2009, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a letter from the source indicating that the existing vapor recovery unit, identified as CD-1, controlling emissions from the loading rack identified as EU LR-1, will be replaced with a new vapor recovery unit of the same type. The new vapor recovery unit will continue to control emissions from the existing loading rack identified as EU LR-1 and continue to be identified as CD-1. This change at the source is considered a "minor physical change" as defined in 326 IAC 2-1.1-1(6). Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-3(h)(2), minor physical changes to a source do not require a permit revision under 326 IAC 2-8-11.1 or an administrative amendment under 326 IAC 2-8-10, if the minor physical change does not increase potential emissions from the source.

No revision to the permit was necessary to accommodate the replacement of the existing control device. All conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect.
