## Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Peaceful Pets Crematory, Inc. was issued a Registration No. R097-22663-00576 on April 6, 2006 for a stationary source for cremation of pet remains located at 5859 East 25<sup>th</sup> Street, Indianapolis, Indiana. On June 17, 2009, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an application from the source requesting that the registration be revised to remove all requirements related to local air pollution control agencies. Local agencies no longer have effective authority to implement state and federal requirements for IDEM. Therefore, IDEM has removed all references to local agencies from the registration. IDEM has determined that this change to the registration will be processed as a notice-only change pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6.

The revised registration specifies that all reports, notices, applications, and any other required submittals shall be submitted to IDEM. The Permittee should note that the local agency could have its own requirements beyond the state and federal requirements contained in the registration. Please contact the local agency for further information.

In addition, IDEM has begun implementing a new procedure and will no longer list the name or title of the Authorized Individual (AI) in registrations. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6, the registration is hereby revised as follows, with deleted language as ~~strikeouts~~ and new language **bolded**:

1. Paragraph (c) (1) through (7) has been removed from the Registration as follows:

~~(c) Pursuant to Chapter 511 "Air Pollution Control Ordinance", Section 511-503, the source shall comply with the following conditions:~~

~~(1) An operator must be in attendance at all times while the crematory is in operation.~~

~~(2) The operator must keep a log (in a form approved by the Administrator) of the number of bodies cremated in each unit, chamber temperature at the beginning of each cremation for each unit, and the dates and times of the cremation for each unit.~~

~~(3) Required records must be kept on-site for three (3) years and available for inspection by the City of Indianapolis Office of Environmental Services (OES).~~

~~(4) An afterburner must be used at all times when the unit is in operation. The afterburner must be operating at a minimum temperature of 1600° F while the crematory is in operation.~~

~~(5) Opacity shall not exceed ten percent (10%) for any six-minute period as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9.~~

- (6) ~~Aside from the animal remains, no additional material other than cardboard or pine may be added to the crematory for incineration.~~
- (7) ~~No cremation may occur between sunset and sunrise unless the unit has a Certified Opacity Monitor (COM) operating at all times during night burning.~~

2. Condition C.2, Fugitive Dust Emissions was added to the registration as follows:

**C.2 Fugitive Dust Emissions [326 IAC 6-4]**

**The Registrant shall not allow fugitive dust to escape beyond the property line or boundaries of the property, right-of-way, or easement on which the source is located, in a manner that would violate 326 IAC 6-4 (Fugitive Dust Emissions).**

3. Several of IDEM's branches and sections have been renamed. Therefore, IDEM has updated the addresses listed in the registration. References to "Compliance Data Section" and "Compliance Branch" have been changed to "Compliance and Enforcement Branch". The registration has been revised as follows:

## SECTION A

## SOURCE SUMMARY

This registration is based on information requested by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality (OAQ). The information describing the source contained in conditions A.1 and A.2 is descriptive information and does not constitute enforceable conditions. However, the Registrant should be aware that a physical change or a change in the method of operation that may render this descriptive information obsolete or inaccurate may trigger requirements for the Registrant to obtain additional permits pursuant to 326 IAC 2.

## SECTION B

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

### B.1 Definitions [326 IAC 2-1.1-1]

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Terms in this registration shall have the definition assigned to such terms in the referenced regulation. In the absence of definitions in the referenced regulation, the applicable definitions found in the statutes or regulations (IC 13-11, 326 IAC 1-2 and 326 IAC 2-1.1-1) shall prevail.

### B.2 Effective Date of Registration [IC 13-15-5-3]

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Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this registration is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

### B.3 Registration Revocation [326 IAC 2-1.1-9]

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Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9 (Revocation), this registration to operate may be revoked for any of the following causes:

- (a) Violation of any conditions of this registration.
- (b) Failure to disclose all the relevant facts, or misrepresentation in obtaining this registration.
- (c) Changes in regulatory requirements that mandate either a temporary or permanent reduction of discharge of contaminants. However, the amendment of appropriate sections of this registration shall not require revocation of this registration.
- (d) For any cause which establishes in the judgment of IDEM the fact that continuance of this registration is not consistent with purposes of this article.

### B.4 Prior Permits Superseded [326 IAC 2-1.1-9.5]

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- (a) All terms and conditions of permits established prior to Registration No. 097-22663-00576 and issued pursuant to permitting programs approved into the state implementation plan have been either:
  - (1) incorporated as originally stated,
  - (2) revised, or
  - (3) deleted.
- (b) All previous registrations and permits are superseded by this registration.

### B.5 Annual Notification [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(3)] [326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(3)]

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Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(3) and 326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(3):

- (a) An annual notification shall be submitted by an authorized individual to the Office of Air Quality stating whether or not the source is in operation and in compliance with the terms and conditions contained in this registration.
- (b) The annual notice shall be submitted in the format attached no later than March 1 of each year to:

- (c) The notification shall be considered timely if the date postmarked on the envelope or certified mail receipt, or affixed by the shipper on the private shipping receipt, is on or before the date it is due. If the document is submitted by any other means, it shall be considered timely if received by IDEM, OAQ on or before the date it is due.

**B.6** Source Modification Requirement [326 IAC 2-5.5-6(a)]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6(a), an application or notification shall be submitted in accordance with 326 IAC 2 to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) if the source proposes to construct new emission units, modify existing emission units, or otherwise modify the source.

**B.7** Registrations [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(i)]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.1-2(i), this registration does not limit the source's potential to emit.

**C.1 Opacity [326 IAC 5-1]**

Pursuant to 326 IAC 5-1-2 (Opacity Limitations), except as provided in 326 IAC 5-1-3 (Temporary Alternative Opacity Limitations), opacity shall meet the following, unless otherwise stated in this registration:

- (a) Opacity shall not exceed an average of thirty percent (30%) in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period as determined in 326 IAC 5-1-4.
- (b) Opacity shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) for more than a cumulative total of fifteen (15) minutes (sixty (60) readings as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9 or fifteen (15) one (1) minute nonoverlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor) in a six (6) hour period.

**C.2 Fugitive Dust Emissions [326 IAC 6-4]**

The Registrant shall not allow fugitive dust to escape beyond the property line or boundaries of the property, right-of-way, or easement on which the source is located, in a manner that would violate 326 IAC 6-4 (Fugitive Dust Emissions).

One (1) pet crematory, with afterburner, identified as 10970, with a maximum operating capacity of 450 pounds per hour (lbs/hr), using natural gas as a supplemental fuel at maximum heat input capacity of 1 million Btu per hour (MMBtu/hr).

### Emission Limitations and Standards [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(1)] [326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(1)]

#### D.1.1 Incinerators [326 IAC 4-2-2]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 4-2-2, pet crematory (emission unit 10970) shall:

- (a) Consist of primary and secondary chambers or the equivalent.
- (b) Be equipped with a primary burner.
- (c) Comply with 326 IAC 5-1 and 326 IAC 2.
- (d) Be maintained, operated, and burn waste in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications or an operation and maintenance plan approved by the Administrator.
- (e) Emission unit 10970 shall not emit particulate matter in excess of three-tenths (0.3) pound of particulate matter per one thousand (1,000) pounds of dry exhaust gas under standard conditions corrected to fifty percent (50%) excess air because the maximum solid waste capacity is greater than or equal to two (200) pounds per hour.
- (f) If any of the above requirements (a) through (e) are not met, then the owner or operator shall stop charging the incinerators until adjustments are made that address the underlying cause of the deviation.
- (g) The incinerators are exempt from requirement (5) if subject to a more stringent particulate matter emissions limit in 40 CFR 52 Subpart P, State Implementation Plan for Indiana.
