## Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Ms. Cupp:

On August 13, 2009, New Millennium Building Systems, LLC located at 6115 County Road 52, Butler, Indiana, submitted a letter informing the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) of the intention to spray paint steel beams using an airless spray gun.

The uncontrolled emissions from this temporary operation are less than the PSD significant levels of 100 tons per year for CO, 40 tons per year for NO<sub>x</sub>, 25 tons per year for PM, 15 tons per year for PM<sub>10</sub>, 10 tons per year for PM<sub>2.5</sub>, 40 tons per year for SO<sub>2</sub>, and 40 tons per year for VOC.

## Temporary Operation General Information

Unit:	An airless spray gun which will spray water based paint that contains no HAPs and less than 3.5 lbs of VOC per gallon less water.
Location of the Operation:	6115 County Road 52, Butler, Indiana
County:	Dekalb
County Status:	Attainment for all criteria pollutants
Purpose of the Temporary Operation:	The Butler site is fabricating and painting 72 steel beams that will be used in a building expansion project by the parent company. They are undertaking this project because their normal operation is slow as a result of the economic recession.
Starting Date of the Operation:	At least seven (7) days from the notification date [326 IAC 2-1.1-3(h)(3)(F)]
Duration of the Operation:	Less than thirty (30) days actual operation time
Pollutants:	VOCs, PM

## Applicable Requirements

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-3(h)(3), the above mentioned temporary operation shall satisfy the following requirements:

- (1) The potential emissions from the operation are less than twenty-five (25) tons for the duration of the operation. [326 IAC 2-1.1-3(g)(3)(A)]
- (2) The operation is not a major source or modification as defined by 326 IAC 2-2, 326 IAC 2-3, or 326 IAC 2-7. [326 IAC 2-1.1-3(g)(3)(B)]

- (3) The purpose of the operation is to:
- (a) temporarily conduct an operation not considered part of the normal operation or production of the facility or source. [326 IAC 2-1.1-3(g)(3)(C)(ii)]
- (4) The duration of the temporary operation or experimental trial is less than thirty (30) days of total operating time. [326 IAC 2-1.1-3(g)(3)(D)]
- (5) The owner or operator shall submit a report containing the following information, at most seven (7) days after concluding the temporary operation or experimental trial:  
[326 IAC 2-1.1-3(g)(3)(G)]
- (a) The actual start date of the construction, reconstruction, or modification.
  - (b) The duration of the temporary operation or experimental trial.
  - (c) The actual emissions occurring during the temporary operation or experimental trial.
