## Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice.** The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Tate & Lyle, Sagamore was issued a Part 70 Operating Permit on June 28, 2004 for the construction of a stationary wet corn milling plant located at 2245 North Sagamore Parkway, Lafayette, Indiana. Furthermore, Tate & Lyle, Sagamore was issued a Significant Source Modification on September 13, 2005 authorizing the construction of new emission units and the modification of existing emissions units. A letter requesting an extension of the 18-month commencement of construction deadline for Significant Source Modification 157-18832-00003 was received on October 5, 2009. The construction deadline found in 326 IAC 2-2-8 (Source Obligation) will be extended based on the following findings:

- (a) There is no Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) increment consumption and no interim source growth in the area that may have occurred and would cause significant degradation of air quality;
- (b) No new federal or state regulations were determined to be applicable to the source; and
- (c) The RACT/BACT/LAER Clearinghouse was reviewed, finding that the technologies to be utilized by Tate & Lyle, Sagamore are still considered BACT in the recent determination.

The last date of construction for emission units permitted under Significant Source Modification 157-18832-00003 was November 24, 2008. Based on the above findings and pursuant to 326 IAC 2-2-8(a)(1) (Source Obligation), commencement of construction for the facilities in the Significant Source Modification 157-18832-00003 shall be extended for eighteen (18) months from the issuance of this Amendment.

Tate & Lyle, Sagamore was issued a Part 70 Operating Permit on June 28, 2004 for the construction of a stationary wet corn milling plant located at 2245 North Sagamore Parkway, Lafayette, Indiana. Furthermore, Tate & Lyle, Sagamore was issued a Significant Source Modification on December 20, 2006 authorizing the construction of new emission units and the modification of existing emissions units. A letter requesting an extension of the 18-month commencement of construction deadline for Significant Source Modification 157-22808-00003 was received on October 5, 2009. The construction deadline found in 326 IAC 2-2-8 (Source Obligation) will be extended based on the following findings:

- (a) There is no Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) increment consumption and no interim source growth in the area that may have occurred and would cause significant degradation of air quality;
- (b) No new federal or state regulations were determined to be applicable to the source; and
- (c) The RACT/BACT/LAER Clearinghouse was reviewed, finding that the technologies to be utilized by Tate & Lyle, Sagamore are still considered BACT in the recent determination.

The last date of construction for emission units permitted under Significant Source Modification 157-22808-00003 was November 24, 2008. Based on the above findings and pursuant to 326 IAC 2-2-8(a)(1) (Source Obligation), commencement of construction for the facilities in the Significant Source Modification 157-22808-00003 shall be extended for eighteen (18) months from the issuance of this Amendment.
