Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Mr. Goldsmith:

Avery Dennison PFD was issued Part 70 Operating Permit Renewal No. 089-18134-00062 on July 14, 2008. The Operating Permit was modified by Administrative Amendment No. 089-27196-00062, issued December 23, 2008. An application to further amend this permit was received by the IDEM OAQ on October 27, 2009. The application requested the addition of the following emission unit:

- (a) One (1) Research & Development paint spray booth, identified as R&D Spray Booth, with a maximum capacity of 1.25 parts per hour.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-3(e)(2), a modification that consists only of processes that have the primary purpose of research and development is considered an exemption, provided that the modification:

- (a) is operated under the close supervision of technically trained personnel;
- (b) is conducted for the primary purpose of theoretical research or research and development into new or improved processes and products;
- (c) does not manufacture more than de minimis amounts of commercial products;
- (d) does not contribute to the manufacture of commercial products by collocated sources in more than a de minimis manner; and
- (e) is not subject to 326 IAC 2-2 or 326 IAC 2-3.

This modification, meeting these requirements, is not subject to the new source requirements of 326 IAC 2-5.1-3 for permits or the modification approval requirements under 326 IAC 2-7-10.5.

Additionally, there are no additional requirements that are applicable to this proposed unit:

- (a) 326 IAC 6-3-2 (Particulate Emissions Limitations for Manufacturing Processes)
The one (1) surface coating unit, identified as R&D Spray Booth, is exempt from the requirements of 326 IAC 6-3-2 pursuant to 326 IAC 6-3-1(b)(15), as this surface coating manufacturing process will use less than five (5) gallons per day.
- (b) 326 IAC 8-1-6 (Best Available Control Technology (BACT))
Pursuant to 326 IAC 8-1-6(1), the one (1) paint spray booth, identified as R&D Spray Booth, is not subject to the requirements of 326 IAC 8-1-6 (BACT), as the potential emissions of this proposed unit are less than twenty-five (25) tons per year.

- (c) 326 IAC 8-2 (Surface Coating Emission Limitations)
Pursuant to 326 IAC 8-2-1(a)(4), the one (1) paint spray booth, identified as R&D Spray Booth, is not subject to the requirements of 326 IAC 8-2, as the emissions from the unit will not exceed fifteen (15) pounds of VOC per day.

Therefore, this unit is not specifically regulated and will not be incorporated into the permit.
