Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Harter Group, Division of Jami, Inc. was issued a Registration No. R039-13730-00121 on February 13, 2002, for a stationary office furniture manufacturing source located at 11451 Harter Drive, Middlebury, IN 46540. On March 16, 2010, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an application from the source requesting that the registration be updated to indicate a change in ownership and company name change to izzy+. This change to the registration is considered a notice-only change pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6(d)(3).

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6, the registration is hereby revised as follows, with deleted language as ~~strikeouts~~ and new language **bolded**:

- (a) The company name throughout the registration has been revised as follows:

Company Name: ~~The Harter Group, Division of Jami Inc.~~ **izzy+**

Upon further review, IDEM, OAQ has decided to make additional revisions to the registration as described below. The registration has been revised as follows with deleted language as ~~strikeouts~~ and new language **bolded**:

- (b) Several of IDEM's branches and sections have been renamed. Therefore, IDEM has updated the address listed in the registration. References to "Compliance Branch" has been changed to "Compliance and Enforcement Branch". The registration has been revised as follows:

~~Compliance Branch~~ **Compliance and Enforcement Branch**

- (c) IDEM has begun implementing a new procedure and will no longer list the name or title of the Authorized Individual (AI) in registrations. The Registration Annual Notification has been revised to remove the authorized individual as follows:

~~Authorized Individual: Les Stoller~~

- (d) IDEM has determined that Condition 4 of the registration is no longer necessary, since the unrestricted potential to emit (PTE) of total HAPs, VOC, PM, and PM10 from the entire source are each less than twenty five (25) tons per year, and the unrestricted potential to emit (PTE) of each single HAP is less than ten (10) tons per. The registration has been revised as follows:

4. ~~Any change or modification which may increase the potential to emit a combination of total HAPs, VOC, PM or PM10 to twenty five (25) tons per year or a single HAP to ten (10) tons per year from this source shall require approval from IDEM, OAQ prior to making the change.~~

(e) IDEM has determined that Condition 5 of the registration is no longer necessary, since the unrestricted potential to emit (PTE) of VOC from the one (1) adhesive application spray booth exhausted through stack S18 is less than fifteen (15) pounds per day. The registration has been revised as follows:

~~5. Any change or modification which increases actual VOC emissions from the one (1) adhesive application spray booth exhausted through stack S18 to fifteen (15) pounds per day or greater, shall cause the facility to be subject 326 IAC 8-2-12 and shall require prior IDEM, OAQ, approval.~~

(f) IDEM has determined that Condition 6 of the registration is no longer necessary, since the unrestricted potential to emit (PTE) of VOC from the entire source is less than the applicability thresholds under 326 IAC 2-6-1 (Emission Reporting) as promulgated on March 27, 2004 (see Indiana Register 27 IR 2210, filed February 26, 2004). The registration has been revised as follows:

~~6. Any change or modification which increases actual VOC or NOX emissions from the entire source to ten (10) tons per year or greater, shall cause the facility to be subject to 326 IAC 2-6 and shall require prior IDEM, OAQ, approval.~~

(g) IDEM has determined that Condition 7 of the registration is no longer necessary, since the unrestricted potential to emit (PTE) of VOC from the one (1) adhesive application spray booth exhausted through stack S18 is less than fifteen (15) pounds per day and the unrestricted potential to emit (PTE) of VOC from the entire source is less than twenty five (25) tons per year. The registration has been revised as follows:


~~7. Records shall be kept of the VOC delivered to the applicators, minus the VOC recovered, in the thirteen (13) adhesive application spray booths. Records shall be kept daily for the one (1) adhesive application spray booth exhausted through stack S18 and monthly for the twelve (12) application spray booths exhausted through stacks S12, S15 and S17. Records shall be submitted to IDEM, OAQ, upon request.~~

(h) The registration has been updated from the letter style format to the permit style format, as is now standard IDEM procedure.

The source shall continue to operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5. Please find enclosed the revised registration. This registration is based on information requested by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality (OAQ). The information describing the source contained in conditions A.1 and A.2 is descriptive information and does not constitute enforceable conditions. However, the Registrant should be aware that a physical change or a change in the method of operation that may render this descriptive information obsolete or inaccurate may trigger requirements for the Registrant to obtain additional permits pursuant to 326 IAC 2.

- (a) Two (2) adhesive application spray booths, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S12, capacity: 28 chairs per hour, total.
- (b) Three (3) adhesive application spray booths, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S13, capacity: 28 chairs per hour, total.
- (c) One (1) adhesive application spray booth, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S14, capacity: 28 chairs per hour, total.
- (d) Three (3) adhesive application spray booths, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S15, capacity: 28 chairs per hour, total.
- (e) Three (3) adhesive application spray booths, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S17, capacity: 28 chairs per hour, total.
- (f) One (1) adhesive application spray booth, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S18, capacity: 1 chair per hour.
- (g) Three (3) natural gas-fired air make-up units, known as H1 - H3, heat input capacity: 1.3 million British thermal units per hour, each.
- (h) Seven (7) natural gas-fired radiant heaters, known as H4 - H10, heat input capacity: 0.035

SECTION B GENERAL CONDITIONS

B.1 Definitions [326 IAC 2-1.1-1]

Terms in this registration shall have the definition assigned to such terms in the referenced regulation. In the absence of definitions in the referenced regulation, the applicable definitions found in the statutes or regulations (IC 13-11, 326 IAC 1-2 and 326 IAC 2-1.1-1) shall prevail.

B.2 Effective Date of Registration [IC 13-15-5-3]

Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this registration is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

B.3 Registration Revocation [326 IAC 2-1.1-9]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9 (Revocation), this registration to operate may be revoked for any of the following causes:

- (a) Violation of any conditions of this registration.
- (b) Failure to disclose all the relevant facts, or misrepresentation in obtaining this registration.
- (c) Changes in regulatory requirements that mandate either a temporary or permanent reduction of discharge of contaminants. However, the amendment of appropriate sections of this registration shall not require revocation of this registration.
- (d) For any cause which establishes in the judgment of IDEM the fact that continuance of this registration is not consistent with purposes of this article.

B.4 Prior Permits Superseded [326 IAC 2-1.1-9.5]

- (a) All terms and conditions of permits established prior to Registration No. 039-13730-00121, and issued pursuant to permitting programs approved into the state implementation plan have been either:
 - (1) incorporated as originally stated,
 - (2) revised, or
 - (3) deleted.
- (b) All previous registrations and permits are superseded by this registration.

B.5 Annual Notification [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(3)] [326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(3)]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(3) and 326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(3):

- (a) An annual notification shall be submitted by an authorized individual to the Office of Air Quality stating whether or not the source is in operation and in compliance with the terms and conditions contained in this registration.
- (b) The annual notice shall be submitted in the format attached no later than March 1 of each year to:

- (c) The notification shall be considered timely if the date postmarked on the envelope or certified mail receipt, or affixed by the shipper on the private shipping receipt, is on or before the date it is due. If the document is submitted by any other means, it shall be considered timely if received by IDEM, OAQ on or before the date it is due.

B.6 Source Modification Requirement [326 IAC 2-5.5-6(a)]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-6(a), an application or notification shall be submitted in accordance with 326 IAC 2 to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) if the source proposes to construct new emission units, modify existing emission units, or otherwise modify the source.

B.7 Registrations [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(i)]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.1-2(i), this registration does not limit the source's potential to emit.

B.8 Preventive Maintenance Plan [326 IAC 1-6-3]

- (a) If required by specific condition(s) in Section D of this permit, the Registrant shall prepare and maintain Preventive Maintenance Plans (PMPs) within ninety (90) days after issuance of this permit or ninety (90) days after initial start-up, whichever is later, including the following information on each facility:

- (1) Identification of the individual(s) responsible for inspecting, maintaining, and repairing emission control devices;
- (2) A description of the items or conditions that will be inspected and the inspection schedule for said items or conditions; and
- (3) Identification and quantification of the replacement parts that will be maintained in inventory for quick replacement.

If, due to circumstances beyond the Registrant's control, the PMPs cannot be prepared and maintained within the above time frame, the Registrant may extend the date an additional ninety (90) days provided the Registrant notifies:

- (b) A copy of the PMPs shall be submitted to IDEM, OAQ upon request and within a reasonable time, and shall be subject to review and approval by IDEM, OAQ. IDEM, OAQ may require the Registrant to revise its PMPs whenever lack of proper maintenance causes or is the primary contributor to an exceedance of any limitation on emissions or potential to emit.
- (c) To the extent the Registrant is required by 40 CFR Part 60 or 40 CFR Part 63 to have an Operation Maintenance, and Monitoring (OMM) Plan for a unit, such OMM Plan is deemed to satisfy the PMP requirements of 326 IAC 1-6-3 for that unit.

Emission Limitations and Standards [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(g)] [326 IAC 2-5.5-4(b)]

C.1 Opacity [326 IAC 5-1]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 5-1-2 (Opacity Limitations), except as provided in 326 IAC 5-1-3 (Temporary Alternative Opacity Limitations), opacity shall meet the following, unless otherwise stated in this registration:

- (a) Opacity shall not exceed an average of forty percent (40%) in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period as determined in 326 IAC 5-1-4.
- (b) Opacity shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) for more than a cumulative total of fifteen (15) minutes (sixty (60) readings as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9 or fifteen (15) one (1) minute nonoverlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor) in a six (6) hour period.

C.2 Fugitive Dust Emissions [326 IAC 6-4]

The Registrant shall not allow fugitive dust to escape beyond the property line or boundaries of the property, right-of-way, or easement on which the source is located, in a manner that would violate 326 IAC 6-4 (Fugitive Dust Emissions).

- (d) Three (3) adhesive application spray booths, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S15, capacity: 28 chairs per hour, total.
- (e) Three (3) adhesive application spray booths, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S17, capacity: 28 chairs per hour, total.
- (f) One (1) adhesive application spray booth, equipped with high volume, low pressure (HVLP) spray guns and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through stack S18, capacity: 1 chair per hour.
- (g) Three (3) natural gas-fired air make-up units, known as H1 - H3, heat input capacity: 1.3 million British thermal units per hour, each.
- (h) Seven (7) natural gas-fired radiant heaters, known as H4 - H10, heat input capacity: 0.035 million British thermal units per hour, each.

Emission Limitations and Standards [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(1)] [326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(1)]

D.1.1 Particulate [326 IAC 6-3-2]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 6-3-2(e), the particulate matter (PM) from the thirteen (13) adhesive application spray booths shall each be limited by the following:

Interpolation of the data for the process weight rate up to sixty thousand (60,000) pounds per hour shall be accomplished by use of the equation:

$$E = 4.10 P^{0.67} \quad \text{where } E = \text{rate of emission in pounds per hour and} \\ P = \text{process weight rate in tons per hour}$$

D.1.2 Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) [326 IAC 8-2-12]

Pursuant to 326 IAC 8-2-12, the surface coating applied to wood furniture and cabinets at the twelve (12) adhesive application spray booths, exhausting to stacks S12, S13, S14, S15 and S17, shall utilize one of the following application methods:

Airless Spray Application
Air Assisted Airless Spray Application
Electrostatic Spray Application
Electrostatic Bell or Disc Application
Heated Airless Spray Application
Roller Coating
Brush or Wipe Application
Dip-and-Drain Application

High volume low pressure (HVLP) spray application is an accepted alternative method of application for air assisted airless spray application. HVLP spray is the technology used to apply coating to substrate by means of coating application equipment which operates between one-tenth (0.1) and ten (10) pounds per square inch gauge (psig) air pressure measured dynamically at the center of the air cap and at the air horns of the spray system.

Compliance Determination Requirements [326 IAC 2-5.1-2(g)] [326 IAC 2-5.5-4(b)]

D.1.3 Particulate

In order to comply with D.1.1, the dry filters for overspray control shall be in operation at all times while the thirteen (13) adhesive application spray booths are in operation.
