Dear Mr. Horn:

The University of Evansville was issued a Source Specific Operating Agreement (SSOA) No. S163-28122-00064 on August 20, 2009 for stationary boilers, generators, other university activities, including maintenance activities located at 1800 Lincoln Avenue, Evansville, Indiana. On August 25, 2010, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a letter from the source requesting that two (2) natural gas fueled internal combustion stationary emergency generators, identified as Unit Number 12 (0.51306 MMBtu/hr) and Unit Number 14 (0.87924 MMBtu/hr), be added. In addition, the University requests that the natural gas fueled steam space heater at the Fehn Guest House (max. heat input capacity of 0.28 MMBtu/hr) be removed. This unit is no longer operational, and is being replaced by a standard residential heating/cooling system.

The OAQ has determined that the addition of the two (2) natural gas fueled internal combustion stationary emergency generators, identified as Unit Number 12 and Unit Number 14, and the removal of the natural gas fueled steam space heater at the Fehn Guest House will not require modification of the existing SSOA, since the existing SSOA contains all the federal and state requirements that are applicable to the new units and the University of Evansville has indicated that it will continue to comply the limitations and requirements contained in SSOA No. S163-28122-00064.

All conditions of the SSOA No. S163-28122-00064 shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter to the front of the original SSOA.
