Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Mr. Fluder:

Sonoco Flexible Packaging was issued Part 70 operating permit (1st renewal) T081-25375-00005 on August 6, 2008, for a stationary commercial printing operation that produces coated and laminated printed packaging for food products. A letter requesting changes to the permit was received on November 15, 2010. The Permittee requests approval for the addition of one (1) solvent storage tank that Sonoco intends to use for storing normal propyl alcohol, and one (1) propane storage tank, each with a storage capacity of 4000 gallons. These emission units have emissions of regulated pollutants that meet the thresholds for insignificant activities included in 326 IAC 2-7-1(21) and are not currently subject to any federal or state regulations under 40 CFR or 326 IAC. Pursuant to the provisions of 326 IAC 2-7-11, an administrative amendment is being issued.

All conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. No changes were necessary to the Part 70 permit.
