Nautic Global Group Inc. dba Rinker Boat Company was issued a Significant Source Modification to its Part 70 Operating Permit on August 4, 2006, authorizing the construction of an expansion project. The Indiana Department of Management, Office of Air Quality (IDEM, OAQ) granted two (2) 18-month construction extension deadlines. However, since construction is not planned to commence prior to the second extension of the construction deadline, IDEM, OAQ decided to revoke the construction approval pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9(5).

Nautic Global Group Inc. has indicated that it is still interested in proceeding with an expansion project in the future and would like to know how IDEM, OAQ could help expedite the required permitting. This letter outlines how IDEM, OAQ intends to assist Nautic Global Group Inc. in the expansion of their operations in Indiana.

IDEM's mission is to implement federal and state regulations to protect human health and the environment while allowing the environmentally sound operations of industrial, agricultural, commercial and government activities vital to a prosperous economy. IDEM, OAQ's Permit Branch has been a leader of this mission by leaning the permitting process to increase customer service and reduce the amount of permit processing time. Indiana has the lowest backlog of Part 70 Operating Permit Renewals in EPA Region V and continues to find ways to improve its business processes.

Since the Nautic Global Group Inc. expansion project has been previously permitted, IDEM, OAQ believes that the in-house processing of a future permit could be expedited. The permit application would be given priority status. This means that the assigned permit writer would work on this project as a priority to complete all of the required permitting documents and that internal reviews and administrative processing would be done as quickly as possible. The significant source modification, authorizing construction, and the significant permit modification, authorizing operation, would need to go through a 30-day public notice period. The significant source modification would then be issued and the significant permit modification would go to EPA for a 15-45 day review period depending on if any significant changes to the permit were made after public notice. After EPA review, the significant permit modification could be issued. The public notice period and EPA review period are out of the control of IDEM, OAQ; however, we would work diligently to reduce the amount of in-house processing time.

IDEM, OAQ would also accept a scaled-back permit application, assuming the scope of the project remains unchanged. At a minimum, the permit application should include a cover letter describing the project, an Air Permit Application Cover Sheet and a GSD-01 form, both of which may be found at: <http://www.in.gov/idem/4819.htm>. IDEM, OAQ would accept the use of the previous permit application and permit documents as long as there was no planned change to the emission units. Any change in the

project would need to be described in more detail with associated calculations. In addition, greenhouse gas calculations should be included for the project.

Another option that could help expedite the ability to construct is an interim significant source modification. The provisions of the rule for interim approvals may be found at 326 IAC 2-13. This would allow for construction to proceed prior to the issuance of the significant source modification. However, operational approval would not be granted until the issuance of the significant permit modification. The application for an interim approval could be submitted concurrently with the application for the project and would need to include certain specific information. It is strongly recommended to discuss this option with IDEM, OAQ before submitting an application. If an interim application is incomplete or contains incorrect rule applicability(ies), IDEM would have to deny the application. Therefore, a pre-application meeting is warranted to specifically address an interim application.

When Nautic Global Group Inc. decides to proceed with the expansion project, representatives of IDEM, OAQ would be happy to meet in person to discuss the scope of the project, the permit application, the permitting process and timeframes, and any new rules which may impact the project.

Indiana works toward being a sought-after location for businesses with a variety of support and incentives. The Indiana Economic Development Corporation (IEDC) cites incentives such as a competitive tax structure, the lowest worker's compensation rates in the Midwest, the second lowest cost for industrial electricity in the nation, no inventory tax, and no gross receipts tax.
