Rieth-Riley Construction Co., Inc. was issued a FESOP No. 097-27199-05319 for construction and operation of a portable drum mix hot asphalt plant, to be located at 1751 West Minnesota Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46221. On, August 3, 2011, OAQ issued Review Request No. 097-30746-05319, which extended the construction time period to February 9, 2012 because the source had not commenced construction.

On November 28, 2011, the source notified OAQ that construction had still not begun for the portable drum mix hot asphalt plant and requested that the commencement of construction time period for these units be extended to August 9, 2012.

There have been no changes in rule applicability in the interim, and there are no pending permits that will consume PSD increment for the local area. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9 and 326 IAC 2-7-10.5(i), the Commissioner may revoke a construction approval, if construction is not commenced within 18 months of the original issuance date of that approval or if construction is suspended for a continuous period of one (1) year or more. However, OAQ exercises the discretion not to revoke FESOP No. 097-27199-05319 issued on February 9, 2010 and extends the construction period to August 9, 2012

No revision to the permit was necessary to accommodate the construction delay. All conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect.
