Dear Vinod C. Shah,

On April 11, 2012, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a letter from Continental Structural Plastics requesting an extension to the eighteen (18) month construction deadline required in Significant Source Modification No. 069-31723-00043, issued on October 6, 2010. The Significant Source Modification (069-31723-00043), was issued for the construction of the following emission units:

- (a) One (1) 500-ton compression molding press, identified as Press 1, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 600 SMC parts per day;
- (b) One (1) 1000-ton compression molding press, identified as Press 2, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day;
- (c) One (1) 1,200-ton Erie compression molding press, identified as Press 3, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SM parts per day;
- (d) One (1) 2,000-ton Williams-White compression molding press, identified as Press 4, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day;
- (e) One (1) 1,500-ton Williams-White compression molding press, identified as Press 5, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day;
- (f) One (1) 2,500-ton Williams-White compression molding press, identified as Press 6, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day;
- (g) One (1) 2,500-ton Williams-White compression molding press, identified as Press 7, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day;
- (h) One (1) 1,200-ton Erie compression molding press, identified as Press 8, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SM parts per day;
- (i) One (1) 2,000-ton compression molding press, identified as Press 9, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day;
- (j) One (1) 1,500-ton compression molding press, identified as Press 10, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day;

- (k) One (1) 1,500-ton compression molding press, identified as Press 11, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day; and
- (l) One (1) 1,000-ton compression molding press, identified as Press 12, approved in 2010 for construction, with a maximum capacity of 450 SMC parts per day.

As of April 11, 2012, the source has constructed seven (7) of the twelve (12) approved compression molding presses. Due to the financial situation of the source, capital expenses required to install the remaining five (5) presses are not available at this time. The purpose of the construction approval extension request is to allow additional time for the construction of the remaining five (5) compression molding presses.

There have been no changes in air rule applicability for the compression molding presses since the date of issuance of Significant Source Modification (069-31723-00043), on October 6, 2010. Furthermore, there are no pending Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) increment consuming permits in process for the local area. As a result, if a new permit to authorize construction was issued on April 11, 2012 (the date that the extension request was received by OAQ), it would have the same requirements as in Significant Source Modification (069-31723-00043).

Therefore, OAQ agrees to extend the eighteen (18) month construction deadline by an additional eighteen (18) months, and will extend the timing to October 6, 2013. This document further amends permit 085-20763-00031 in a similar manner: Therefore, the date for the commencement of construction shall be extended until October 6, 2013. If construction does not commence on or before this date, additional approval from the Office of Air Quality shall be required.

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this amendment with the original source modification permit.
