Notice of Decision: Approval - Effective Immediately

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this permit is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3 and IC 13-15-6-1 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days of the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

On August 10, 2012, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an interim Minor Source Modification petition from Heartland Automotive, LLC, located at 300 South Warren Drive, Greencastle, Indiana. Based on the data and information submitted in the petition and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-13-1, this interim Minor Source Modification petition is hereby approved for:

One (1) surface coating booth, identified as MAP-2, using HVLP spray applicators, equipped with a water curtain for particulate control and exhausting to Stack MAP-2, capacity: 34 plastic parts per hour. Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP, this is considered an existing affected coating operation.

Detailed conditions will be specified in the final Minor Source Modification 133-32198-00027. This interim Minor Source Modification will expire on the effective date of the final Minor Source Modification. This interim Minor Source Modification may be revoked after its effective date upon a written finding by the OAQ that any of the reasons for denial in 326 IAC 2-13-1(h) exist or if the final Minor Source Modification is denied. The facilities subject to this approval may not operate until the final Significant Permit Modification is issued by OAQ.



PSD Requirements:

The potential to emit is less than the PSD Significant levels, therefore, PSD rules and requirements do not apply.

The emissions of VOC are limited to less than 246 tons per year by permit condition and the new MAP-2 surface coating operation will comply with this emissions limitation.

NSPS Requirements:

There is no applicable NSPS rule applicable to this operation or equipment.

NESHAP Requirements:

Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP, this is considered a new affected coating operation. For both new and existing affected sources, the general limit of 0.16 kg HAP per kg or solids applies. Greencastle currently meets this limit with compliant materials, but has a thermal oxidizer installed on the SCL coating operation that could be used if needed to meet this limitation.



D.1.1 PSD Minor Limit [326 IAC 2-2] The total VOC input, including coatings, dilution solvents, and cleaning solvents to the VF/EF/HS, SB-1 and SB-2, AB-1 through AB-4, TPB, MAP-1, MAP-2 IP-1 and SCL shall not exceed 246 tons per twelve (12) consecutive month period with compliance determined at the end of each month.

Compliance with the above limits in conjunction with VOC emissions from the insignificant activities at the source shall limit the VOC emissions from the entire source to less than 250 tons per twelve (12) consecutive month period. Therefore, this is a minor source under 326 IAC 2—2.


