Dear Mr. Saul:

On August 15, 2012, Ball Metal Beverage Container Corporation submitted a letter requesting approval from the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) for the replacement of three (3) old baghouses with a single, large baghouse that is designed to control the particulates from five lines. This baghouse is a particulate control device that the spray machines (Sources ISM-1, ISM-2, ISM-3, ISM-4 and ISM-5) vent to. There is no permit ID associated with the baghouses.

This project is being driven by the age and condition of the existing baghouses and to upgrade the system to better handle combustible dusts. The permit condition regarding compliance monitoring in Condition D.1.10(a) will not be affected by this replacement.

IDEM has reviewed the information provided by the source and has made the following determination based on the following:

- This replacement is not prohibited by any applicable permit;
- This project will result in no increase in emissions; and
- No changes in the current air permit emission limitations or conditions are required.

All conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter to the front of the original permit.
