Notice of Decision: Approval - Effective Immediately

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this permit is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3 and IC 13-15-6-1 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days of the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

On May 8, 2013, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an interim Significant Source Modification petition from Newton County Landfill, located at 2266 E. 500 South Rd., in Brook, Indiana for construction of pug mill operation, including two silos, for mixing fly ash with leachate.

A public notice of the interim Significant Source Modification petition was published in Rensselaer Republican on May 3, 2013. The public comment period ended on May 17, 2013.

There were no comments received during the public comment period. This interim Significant Source Modification petition is in effect upon issuance and will expire on the effective date of the final Significant Source Modification permit.

This interim Significant Source Modification petition is in effect upon issuance and will expire on the effective date of the final Significant Source Modification permit.

The interim Significant Source Modification petition may be revoked after the effective date upon a written finding by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) that any of the reasons for denial in 326 IAC 2-13-1(h) exist or if the final Significant Source Modification permit is denied. The IDEM has reviewed this interim Significant Source Modification petition and has not found any such reason. The facilities subject to this approval may not operate until the final Significant Permit Modification is issued by OAQ. Operation of the facilities subject to this approval will be governed by 326 IAC 2-7-12 (b)(7).

The interim Significant Source Modification petition is federally enforceable. Detailed construction and operation conditions will be specified in the final Significant Source Modification permit 111-33012-00017.





Description of the Operation or Equipment:

Newton County Landfill Partnership respectfully submits this petition for interim permit application for the pug mill operation to be located at the Newton County Landfill (NCL).

The pug mill system will operate as a closed loop system. Below is a detailed system operation description.

Fly ash from another outside facility will be transported in a dry condition to the landfill using dry bulk trailers. Two silos with approximate capacity of 12,000 cubic feet each will be installed for storage of dry fly ash. The silo will be equipped with an anti-overfill device for monitoring of the fly ash level in the silo. Processing rate will not exceed 30,000 tons per year.

Fly ash will discharge through screw conveyor. The screw conveyor will discharge into a mixer that will condition the fly ash with leachate. The mixer will condition dry fly ash and discharge it into an off road dump truck for transport to the desired location within the landfill.

The pug mill system is equipped with a cartridge filter dust collector. The cartridge dust collector is an automatic self-cleaning dust collector. The only source of emissions from the pug mill operation is the particulate matter emissions passing through the filters. All other moving equipment and motors are electric. Existing roadways are already permitted under the landfill permit.

Potential to Emit:

The total uncontrolled particulate matter (PM) potential to emit are 658.10 ton per year, the PM₁₀ potential to emit are 223.50 ton per year and PM_{2.5} potential to emit are 223.50 ton per year. Methodology and calculations of the potential to emit before and after control device are attached in detail as Appendix A.

PSD Requirements:

NCL is located in Newton County, which is currently considered attainment for all criteria pollutants. NCL is currently a minor stationary source under PSD. The proposed installation throughput will be limited to 30,000 ton per year. Since the estimated allowable emissions from the proposed installation will be less than 250 ton per year, PSD regulations are not applicable to the proposed installation.

NSPS Requirements:

There are no NSPS applicable to this operation or equipment.

NESHAP Requirements:

There is no applicable NESHAP rule to this operation or equipment.

State Rules & Requirements:

Rule 326 IAC 5-1-2(1) of the Indiana Administrative Code apply to this operation. As such, visible emissions from a source or facility located in an attainment area for particulate matter shall not exceed an average 40% opacity in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period. Also, visible emissions shall not exceed 60% opacity for more than a cumulative total of fifteen (15) minutes (sixty (60) reading as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9 or fifteen (15) one (1) minute non-overlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor) in a six (6) hour period.

Rule 326 IAC 6-3-2 of the Indiana Administrative Code apply to this operation. The allowable rate of emission is based on the process weight rate for the pugmill operation. Calculation of the allowable emission rate is shown below:





Greenlee pockets 500th win

Milestone comes in Kankakee Valley's 17-3 win over West Central

When Kankakee Valley took the lead in both games this week against Munster, players for the Kougars began stealing glances at the water cooler that rested in their dugout.

The players were prepared to douse coach Doug Greenlee with the water in anticipation of their skipper's 500th win. Instead, Munster doused KV's hopes for a win, rallying for a 7-6 win in walk-off fashion on Monday and erasing a 1-0 deficit in a 4-1 victory on Tuesday.

A win at West Central, however, seemed inevitable. The Trojans have struggled to a 1-12 start and KV came to Francesville Thursday hungry for a win.

So it was no surprise that the Kougars, who have shown signs of improvement after a 6-13 start, jumped ahead of West Central, 10-3, after three innings.

All that was left was whether Greenlee's 500th win would come via the 10-run rule or not. It didn't, but KV cruised to a 17-3 final in seven innings.

With Greenlee outside the visitor's dugout wiping away tears as the final outs were recorded Thursday, the post-game celebration was subdued somewhat since both teams had to prepare for the JV game to follow.

In a class move by West Central Athletic Director Chuck Evans, Greenlee's milestone was announced over the P.A. just seconds after relief pitcher Matt Berdine struck out Luke Owens for the game's final out.

After a brief meeting with his players, Greenlee, who turns 54 on May 5, turned his attention to the next opponent, South Newton, which the Kougars were to host on Friday.

"500 is just a number, but it's also a milestone and something you'll always remember," Greenlee said. "But I'm a competitor. I'm glad it's over and now we can get ready for the next game."

Also forgotten are those near-wins against Munster earlier in the week. The Kougars gave Greenlee a glimmer of hope for win No. 500 on Monday, leading 5-1 against the Mustangs, who rallied for the win. Both losses to Munster dropped KV to 1-9 in the Northwest Crossroads Conference.

"Those were big

games. We're 1-9 in our conference, but we're not a bad ball club," Greenlee said. "Our conference is just brutal with the pitching you face, but it makes us better. I'm really proud of how the team came out tonight. They swung the bats a little bit."

The Kougars had 17 runs on 17 hits and used a five-run second inning to take control early. With the lead well in hand, Greenlee turned to ace pitcher Jack Miles to finish off the Trojans.

Miles allowed no runs in four innings of work before Berdine finished up with a scoreless seventh inning.

Miles had Munster fooled for five innings on Tuesday before the Mustangs rallied with three runs in the top of the sixth.

"He only threw 56 pitches Tuesday, so he's pretty durable," Greenlee said of Miles.

"The kids work hard, and I think they're getting better, and that's what I like more than anything. It's a good feeling to see them improve."

As the team closed in on Greenlee's milestone, Miles said the Kougars became much more focused, which in turn led to improved play.

"Not everybody knew about it (milestone) at the beginning of the year," Miles said. "It's just this past month that we've been looking at it. We knew he was close and it's actually helped us play better as we got

closer to it."

Like many of his teammates, Miles thought his coach would get No. 500 as early as Monday at Munster.

"That was one of the better games we played this year," he said of the 7-6 loss. "Hitting-wise, too. That was the first game where we actually hit the ball. You just have to put the loss aside and look at what you did good."

When asked to reminisce on his most memo-

orable moments as coach at KV, Greenlee said the semistate years of 1998 and 1999 were pretty special. Twice the Kougars came within a few runs of playing for a state championship downstate. Greenlee has averaged nearly 18 wins per season over 28 years as head coach to reach his milestone, including 10 straight seasons of 20 wins or more.

"We were so fortunate in the '90s. We won 20 or more every year,"

Greenlee said. "We had a good run there. Since that time, we've got Andrean in our sectional and in our conference and they've won state championship after state championship. We have to up our level of play. We've played them tough many times. We've just never got over the hump with them. But you don't think of those things. You think of the fun times."

Among those to witness Greenlee's 500th coaching win Thursday

were parents Dee and Tish Greenlee, who made the trip from near Greencastle to see their son. Wife Shelly was also in attendance.

Greenlee said he has received great support from family, friends and a multitude of coaches.

"I think back to all the coaches who have been with me. (Varsity assistant coach) Ryan Armstrong has been with me through a lot of those years, playing and coaching. It means a lot to me to have him around for this," Greenlee said.

Armstrong was a key member of KV's best teams in the early 1990s. Once he returned to KV to teach, he became a valued member of Greenlee's staff.

"It's great to finally get it for him. I know he's been looking forward to it," Armstrong said. "It's a pretty big milestone. I'm pretty happy for him. It couldn't have happened to a better guy."

Armstrong added that working alongside Greenlee is much different than playing for him.

The maximum indemnity payable for the reconstruction of nonnegotiable documents under Express Mail document reconstructing insurance is \$50,000 per piece subject to a limit of \$50, 000 per occurrence. The maximum indemnity payable on Express mil merchandise insurance is \$500. The maximum indemnity payable is \$25,000 for registered mail, sent with optional postal insurance. See Domestic Mail Manual R900, S913, and S921 for limitations of coverage on inured and COD mail. See International Mail Manual for limitations o coverage on international mail. Special handling charges apply only to Standard Mail (A) and Standard Mail (B) parcels.
