Notice of Decision: Approval - Effective Immediately

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this permit is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3 and IC 13-15-6-1 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Suite N 501E, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days of the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

On June 25, 2013, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an interim significant source modification petition from Heartland Automotive, LLC located at 300 South Warren Drive, Greencastle, Indiana 46135. Based on the data and information submitted in the petition and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-13-1, this interim significant source modification petition is hereby approved for:

- (a) One (1) surface coating booth, identified as MAP-3, approved in 2013 for construction, using HVLP spray applicators, equipped with a water curtain for particulate control and exhausting to Stack MAP-3, capacity: 34 plastic parts per hour. Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP, this is considered part of an existing affected coating operation.
- (b) One (1) surface coating booth, identified as MAP-4, approved in 2013 for construction, using HVLP spray applicators, equipped with a water curtain for particulate control and exhausting to Stack MAP-4, capacity: 34 plastic parts per hour. Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP, this is considered part of an existing affected coating operation.
- (c) One (1) surface coating booth, identified as MAP-5, approved in 2013 for construction, using HVLP spray applicators, equipped with a water curtain for particulate control and exhausting to Stack MAP-5, capacity: 34 plastic parts per hour. Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP, this is considered part of an existing affected coating operation.
- (d) One (1) surface coating line, identified as SCL_MAP, approved in 2013 for construction consisting of one (1) spray booth, using HVLP spray applicators, equipped with a wet scrubber for particulate control and exhausting to Stacks SCL_MAP, capacity: 34 plastic vehicle parts per hour. Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP, this is considered part of an existed affected coating operation.

Public notice of the interim significant source modification petition was published on July 10, 2013. The public comment period ended on July 24, 2013. Since there are no comments received during the public

comment period, pursuant to 326 IAC 2-13-1(i), the interim significant source modification petition is in effect upon issuance, and expires on the effective date of the final significant source modification permit. The interim significant source modification petition may be revoked after this effective date upon a written finding by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) that any of the reasons for denial in 326 IAC 2-13-1(h) exist or if the final significant source modification is denied. The IDEM has reviewed this interim significant source modification petition and has not found any such reason. The facilities specified in the interim significant source modification petition may be constructed upon issuance of this interim approval. Operational approval will be granted in accordance with 326 IAC 2-7-12.

The interim significant source modification petition is federally enforceable. Detailed construction and operation conditions will be specified in the final significant source modification permit no. 133-33181-00027.

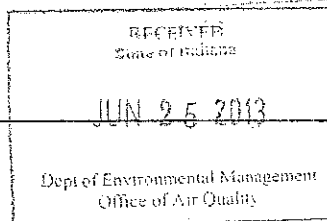

Four (4) surface coating booths, identified as MAP-3, MAP-4, MAP-5 and SCL-MAP, using HVLP spray applicators, equipped with a water curtain for particulate control exhausting to Stacks MAP-3, MAP 4, MAP-5 and SCL-MAP, capacity: 34 plastic parts per hour. Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPP, this is considered a new affected coating operation.

Potential to Emit:

VOC Potential to Emit:

MAP-3, MAP-4, MAP-5 and SCL-MAP = 7.09 tpy

PM (PM10 and PM2.5) Potential to Emit:

MAP-3, MAP-4, MAP-5 = 0.72 tpy

SCL-MAP = 0.26 tpy

HAP Potential to Emit:

MAP-3, MAP-4, MAP-5 = 1.74 tpy

SCL-MAP = 0.08 tpy

PSD Requirements:

The potential to emit is less than the PSD significant levels, therefore PSD rules and requirements do not apply.

The emissions of VOC are limited to less than 246 tons per year by permit condition and the new MAP-3, MAP-4, MAP-5 and SCL-MAP surface coating operation will comply with this emissions limitation.

NSPS Requirements:

There is no applicable NSPS rule applicable to this operation or equipment.

NESHAP Requirements:

Under 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP, this is considered a new affected coating operation. For both new and existing affected sources, the general limit of 0.16 kg HAP per kg or solids applies. Greencastle currently meets this limit with compliant materials, but has a thermal oxidizer installed on the SCL coating operation that could be used if needed to meet this limitation.

The total VOC input, including coatings, dilution solvents, and cleaning solvents to the MAP-3, MAP-4, MAP-5 and SCL-MAP shall not exceed 246 tons per twelve (12) consecutive month period with compliance determined at the end of each month. The amount of VOC in waste shipped offsite may be deducted from the reported monthly VOC input.


Compliance with the above limits in conjunction with VOC emissions from the insignificant activities at the source shall limit the VOC emissions from the entire source to less than 250 tons per twelve (12) consecutive month period. Therefore, this is a minor source under 326 IAC 2-2.

There is no applicable State Rules & Requirements applicable to this operation or equipment.
