Dear Mr. Findley:

C.P. Incorporated was issued a Permit by Rule No.: 041-20164-00012 on October 16, 2007, for a stationary for a paint manufacturing source, located at South 2nd & Water Streets, Connersville, Indiana 47331. On February 18, 2016, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a letter from the source requesting that the Permit by Rule be revoked because the source ceased operation on August 1, 2015 and all emission units were sold and removed from the source.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any cause that establishes in the judgment of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of 326 IAC 2. Since the source is no longer in operation, the Permit by Rule is no longer required.

The Permit by Rule No.: 041-20164-00012 issued on October 16, 2007, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective in eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.

Please be advised that once this revocation is effective the source will no longer have approval to operate any emission units at this source. In addition, if there is a need in the future to operate any units at this source, construction and operation approval will be necessary pursuant to Indiana's New Source Review regulations. Once effective, this revocation cannot be withdrawn or rescinded.
